Import with Meerkat

If you want to import objects from Second Life to New World Grid it is possible with the [Meerkat Viewer](#) (free).

It is necessary that the objects are Full Perm. If you are not the creator of the items you want to import, thank you to contact the creator and ask permission before importing. Full Perm on Second Life does not mean Full Perm or allow for another virtual world.

Respect for copyright is very important.

We will then show you how do for Import items. Attention Meerkat not upolad content of objects.

- 1 Launch the Meerkat Viewer, configure it to log on Second Life with the button : Grid Manager and identify you
- 2 Look in your inventory the object you want import and drop on the ground



- 3 Right Click : More > More > Backup
